

657133 Bigz™ XL Cupcake, 3-D (Pop-Up) by Karen Burniston



1. Die-cut from chosen material, fold and apply adhesive as shown.



2. Adhere the two Cupcake pieces to the middle two sections of the Cupcake body with the pointed tabs towards each other and the bottom edge of the tab aligned with the fold. (Note: There should be a round tab protruding from beneath the cupcake piece on the right.)



3. Join the long tab to the opposite side of the Cupcake body to create the cube-shaped base.



4. Flatten the base. Fold over the Cupcake pieces and adhere the two remaining triangular Cupcake tabs to the opposite side of the base as shown.



5. Expand the base, making sure that the round tabs slide beneath as the opposing sides come together.



6. Collapse the base flat again, while pressing the Cupcake pieces down into the base.


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
7. The Cupcake is now ready to be placed.



8. Align the triangle tab so the bottom edge meets the middle fold of the card. The minimum card size to hide the Cupcake is A2 (4.25" x 5.5").



9. To adhere the opposite side, lay the Cupcake flat with the adhesive exposed and close the card.



10. Embellish as desired. The wider side of the cherry can be glued to the front flap so that the fold in the cherry is in the gap between the halves. Do not glue down the other side of the cherry. Separate side pieces can be embossed or embellished individually and attached to the base. Scalloped embellishment may be added to the embellished side pieces or directly to the base. When opening the card, a slight back bend will expand the Cupcake completely for display.
